ADMISSION NOTICE

Applications are invited for Admission to Three Years General Nursing & Midwifery Course for only females, unmarried or widowed without any encumbrance. Candidates has to apply on the prescribed application form which is attached with Brochure obtainable from the Panna Dai School of Nursing, D.D.U.Hospital on payment of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) for General/ OBC Candidates & Rs. 600/- (Rupees Six Hundred Only) for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Candidates through Demand Draft in favour of <u>Medical Director</u>, <u>D.D.U.Hospital</u>, <u>Payable at New Delhi</u>, between 10A.m. to 1P.m. On all working days except Saturday, Sundays and other holidays from 02.08.2022 to 22.08.2022. Last date of receiving application form is 22.08.2022, 2p.m. Monday, with self attested photo copies of all certificates. Incomplete applications form will be summarily rejected. Seats available is 30 (Thirty). Over and above this, 10% of the 30 seats are for EWS as per INC directives.

1. ELIGIBILITY:

- i. Higher Secondary (10+2) CBSE Board or any other equivalent recognized board in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Psychology, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Computer Science/Informatics Practice/Word Processing/Multimedia, Civic, History, Political Science, Economics, Commerce, Home Science, Sociology and Mathematics. Preference will be given to candidates with Physics, Chemistry and Biology. From the subjects given above, the candidate should have 40% or more marks in aggregate in the best three subjects excluding English. Pass in English is compulsory.
- ii. Those who have successfully completed ANM Course with aggregate of 40% or more marks (10+2 Vocational) from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.

iii. For Foreign Nationals

The entry qualification equivalency is 12th Standard, to be obtained from Association of Indian University New Delhi. State Nursing Council will certify the equivalency to what has been prescribed in point no. (i) as above.

2. AGE:

Age should not be below 17 Years and not more than 35 Years as on 31.12.2022 Upper age relaxation of upto five years is given to candidates belonging to SC/ST Category.

There is no age bar for ANM/LHV.
